Course Description

- Completion of a full time studies in Australia towards a Certificate III level course or above;
- English as the first language;
- Satisfactory completion of the EAL course OR
- Any other form of test which satisfies the Institution.

Teaching Method

Teaching is conducted in the classroom as well as in general health service settings when required to simulate real work environment. The delivery will include face to face teaching, lectures, discussions.
