English Language Requirements

All International Students applying for courses at AITT must have a minimum English Language proficiency level of one of the below:

You should qualify in ANY ONE (1) of the following:

- IELTS overall band of 5.5 or equivalent;
- TOEFL iBT test score band of 46 equivalent or above;
- PTE Academic band score 42 equivalent or above;
- Cambridge English Advanced (CAE) test score band of 47 equivalent or above;
- OET score band Pass equivalent or above;
- Successful completion of Senior Secondary certificate of education in Australia conducted in medium of English;
- Completion of a full time studies in Australia towards a Certificate III level course or above;
- English as the first language;
- Satisfactory completion of the EAL course OR
- Any other form of test which satisfies the Institution.

Teaching Methods

Teaching is conducted in the classroom as well as in the automotive workshop when required to simulate real work environment. The delivery will include face to face teaching, lectures, discussions, research, learning activities, group work, and supervised practical sessions.

Students undertaking this course will also have access to AITT-Automotive Workshop at 8B James Street, Clayton South, VIC 3169.

Assessments

Assessments comprise of written test, knowledge based quiz, practical, and case study projects.
